Funding Marine 27 A Project by the Fire Auxiliary Team

Funding Goal: About \$49,000 is needed to repair and equip the 30 foot boat that was used by the Navy and was free to the Fire District.

Funds Received So Far: About \$32,000 (65% of goal)

About \$24,000 from a state grant. Fund raising and donations make up the rest.

What Does The Boat Need?

Short Answer: Everything. From the very basic boating gear like fenders, lines, and lights to Coast Guard required safety items like life jackets, horn, life ring, navigation lights, and anchors. Also, all the electrical system from batteries, wiring and switches. Add the emergency equipment like spot lights, siren, towing gear, fire fighting equipment, and deck storage boxes. Plus the essential electronics like radio, chartplotter, AIS, night camera, and depth sounder. Add, the desire to expand the cabin to transport a patient.
